

January 21st, 2020

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Tuesday, January 21st, 2020, with Chairman Tom Broeker, Vice-Chair Jim Cary and Member Bob Beck present.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Meet with Department Heads: County Auditor Terri Johnson stated the Burlington School District has called for a Special Election on March 3rd to submit for approval a Revenue Purpose Statement. The Ft Madison School District also called for a special election on March 3rd for a VPPEL question. However, Des Moines County only has 38 registered voters for this school district so the control county, Lee has been designated to conduct this election. Safety Director Angela Vaughan reminded everyone it is slick outside after the snow/rain event over the weekend and to be careful. Maintenance Supervisor Rodney Bliesener reported the state elevator inspector was here in December and the elevators passed inspection. He praised the maintenance crew for coming in Saturday to remove snow before the cold spell set in. Chief Deputy Brett Grimshaw stated the jail population is 94. CDS Director Ken Hyndman stated his budget meeting will take place after the board meeting today. He thanked the maintenance crew for clearing the parking lot and sidewalks at his office and the Cottonwood Facility. County Engineer Brian Carter thanked his road crews and reported they worked until 6PM on Friday to clear roads and the trucks were back out on Saturday until the afternoon. The road graders ran from 5AM to 6PM on Saturday. Carter warned everyone to be careful when traveling on gravel roads. The motor graders have been roughing up the roads to break up the ice but there is no magic wand to remove ice from gravel roads. Salt is not used on gravel roads and he explained why gravel roads stay icy compared to paved roads. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter reported they are still working on the ordinance updates. Others present were: County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist, IT Director Colin Gerst, Local Health Administrator Christa Poggemiller and Conservation Director Chris Lee.

Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$908,278.24 was presented. Beck motioned to approve and seconded by Cary.

County Engineer Brian Carter presented Contract Rock Documents for L&W Quarries in the amount of \$175,319 and for Douds Stone LLC in the amount of \$41,127.50. Cary motioned to approve and seconded by Beck.

A Resolution authorizing the County Engineer to digitally approve the Mediapolis Bridge contracts was presented. Carter stated both bridges will be built at the same time, therefore closing a portion of Mediapolis Road for four to five months once the project starts. Beck motioned to approve and seconded by Cary.

Cary motioned to approve the January 14th, 2020 meeting minutes and seconded by Beck.

Canvass results of election for Two Rivers Levee & Drainage District Trustees. Colin Wagenbach received thirteen (13) votes and Steve Mullahy received thirteen (13) votes. Both were declared winners for a three-year term. Beck motioned to approve and seconded by Cary.

Committee reports. Cary attended a Southeast Iowa Crime Commission meeting. The Director's job evaluation was conducted and received a good report. He attended a RUSS meeting and an Iowa Workforce meeting. The State is not allowing Workforce to realign until all sixteen regions are in compliance, the deadline is April 1st. Broeker attended a Mental Health & Disabilities Service meeting.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:25 AM.

Following the meeting were four work sessions. The first work session with Bob Bartles/Hope Haven Executive Director to discuss the Cottonwood Facility. Hope Haven leases the facility from the County and plans to change the facility to a Dual Diagnosis Facility for mental health and substance abuse issues. They will be partnering with ADDS and Young House for this service. The current residents will be relocated to community-based housing. The Dual Diagnosis will not be a locked facility program. The second work session was a budget meeting with CDS Director Ken Hyndman regarding the Mental Health and Disabilities Service and General Assistance budgets. The third work session was a budget meeting with the Budget Director and County Auditor regarding the Non-Departmental, Supervisors, Medical Examiner and Clerk of Court budgets.
