Re: Background info for March 2, 2022 Board Meeting

Here is some background information regarding the items on the March Board Meeting agenda:

Project Updates

- We set poles to attach duckweed barriers to around the beach swimming area. Have quotes for the floating booms.
- Wellmark grant has been submitted. Working on LWCF grant now.
- Lots of legislative activity this month. Likely more to come. See emails from ICCS for details.
- We will be co-hosting a Master Conservationist class (ISU Extension program) with Henry County.
- Wood duck box inspections are done.
- The Youth Jamboree will be on June 4 this year. That corresponds with Free Fishing Weekend and hopefully gets us out of the consistent bad weather we've seen in May. We will need volunteers to help so if you're free and can help, contact Kelly.

Old Business

Budget – update on the status of the budget. Also discussion on expenditures for duckweed control and water quality monitoring.

New Business

LWCF Grant Resolution – this is the resolution in support of the Land and Water Conservation Fund grant application that is due March 15.

Big Hollow Lake Access/Driving off-road vehicles on ice – we've received numerous requests from ice fishermen for better access to the lake near the dam. Some have even offered to donate to putting in a parking lot at or near the dam. We've also had requests for people to drive ATV/UTV's on the ice. This is allowed by permit on state lakes and there's been confusion as to why it's not allowed at Big Hollow.

Des Moines County Conservation is dedicated to the sustainability of natural resources through land stewardship, conservation education, and by providing quality outdoor recreation opportunities.

Our stance has always been that with the springs in the lake and the unpredictable nature of the ice there, we didn't want the liability. But since it's been brought up, we should at least discuss it again. I have a query into our insurance provider to get their stance and to other counties to see how they manage the situation on their lakes. An alternative may be to implement a paid permit system similar to our shooting range where we make people watch a video that discusses the risks, then have them waive us of liability by purchasing the permit. I expect there will be some from the public show up to discuss the issue.

Informational Items

Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission will attend the meeting to present us an award we/they received for the Greater Burlington Bike and Pedestrian Plan.

CREDIT TERMS Payment is due within 30 days of the invoice date or 30 days within receipt of invoice, whichever is later. The State Hygienic Laboratory (SHL) accepts check and credit cards for payment of services. Credit card payments are only accepted on the SHL website: https://www.shl.uiowa.edu/financial/invoice_pay.html. Credit Cards accepted are MasterCard, Visa and Discover. INVOICING SHL will generate invoices at the end of each month. Invoices for environmental testing will only be delivered by postal mail, fax, or email. Preferably emailed invoices should be sent to shared email accounts such as an account payable address.

Accounts more than 60 days past due are subject to accrual of interest at the maximum rate allowed by law, computed daily until payment is received.

RUSH ANALYSES Rush analyses are available for an additional charge and must be arranged in advance. If, for unforeseen reasons, the rush turnaround time cannot be met, the normal price will apply.

PRICE QUOTATIONS Extra preparation required for samples with problem matrices or special report deliverables may incur additional charges. Unless otherwise agreed to in advance, all work will be performed at the SHL's current fee schedule.

SAMPLE BOTTLES/SPECIMEN KITS The SHL will provide site-specific sampling kits and shipping containers to clients within the contiguous United States. This project will install sidewalks at the beach and to an existing kayak launch dock, replacing soft, natural surfaces and stairs with accessible paved routes. 3. That it has the ability and intention to finance its share of the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of said County for public outdoor recreational use.
4. That no financial assistance has been given or promised under any other federal program or activity with regard to the proposed project.
5.
