

May 2, 2023

The Des Moines County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at the Court House in Burlington at 9 AM on Tuesday, May 2, 2023, with Chair Shane McCampbell, Vice-Chair Tom Broeker and Member Jim Cary present. This meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Meeting with Department Heads: Public Health Director Christa Poggemiller reported her office is still holding Covid vaccine clinics. The Public Health Covid Emergency ends May 11<sup>th</sup>, but test kits will still be available to the public. County Attorney Lisa Schaeffer reported her office is accepting applications for a Records Clerk. Safety Director Angela Vaughan was present. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener stated he will attend a pre-construction meeting for the Jail roof project this afternoon. SEIL CDS Director Ken Hyndman reported Elevate has won the bid for mobile crisis for our area. He will be working with their staff to get the contract done. County Treasurer Janelle Nalley-Londquist reported her staff is busy preparing for tax sale. They have mailed out roughly 1,200 delinquent notices this past week. Conservation Director Chris Lee stated the Summer Camp sign up opened last week. They have around 90 signed up so far. Boat ramps at Big Hollow are closed currently. Sheriff Kevin Glendening stated his two new Deputies started the academy yesterday. The jail population is 70. The Sheriff's Department will hold their Youth Academy graduation tomorrow night. IT Director Colin Gerst reported his office is busy. Assistant Land Use Administrator Jarred Lassiter would like to let the public know that there is a Zoning Ordinance in the County. Whether you are wanting to add an addition, build a detached garage or shed, new construction, or any kind of construction, please check there isn't a permit needed before going forward with your plans. County Engineer Brian Carter stated the Mississippi River keeps rising. Water is to the edge of Tama Road currently and the road remains open. Sullivan Slough Road is still closed and will be closed for a short time. Highway 99 bridge project is waiting for the next phase from the contractor. Bridgeport Road is still closed, and the contractor is hoping to have it finished and open mid-week next week. County Auditor Sara Doty stated the Rural Spring Clean-Up is still in effect until June 10<sup>th</sup>.

No correspondence was received.

Approval of OCIO MOU Contract was presented. IT Director Colin Gerst spoke on this. Cary made a motion to approve and was seconded by Broeker.

Approval of Payroll Reimbursement Claims in the amount of \$237.34 were presented. Broeker made a motion to approve and seconded by Cary.

Approval of Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$390,439.95 was presented. Broeker made a motion to approve and seconded by Cary.

Approval of a Class C Liquor License at Myers Wedding Barn for the Minnis Wedding on 5/6/23 was presented. Broeker made a motion to approve and seconded by Cary.

Approval of a Class C Liquor License at Myers Wedding Barn for the Wilkins/Boyer Wedding on 6/10/23 was presented. Cary made a motion to approve and was seconded by Broeker.

Personnel Actions – Sheriff – Klay Foster, Deputy New Hire, beginning 4/27/23 at \$48,873.62 yearly. Brett Haubrich, Deputy New Hire, beginning on 4/28/23 at \$48,873.62 yearly. Broeker made a motion to approve both personnel actions and was seconded by Cary.

Cary motioned to approve the April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023, regular meeting minutes and seconded by Broeker.

Broeker requested a Resolution to be presented next Tuesday, May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023, showing the allocation of ARPA Funds for Des Moines County.

McCampbell attended an E911 Board Meeting. Broeker attended a Public Health Committee, SEIL Governing Board, and a Southeast Iowa Regional Riverboat Commission meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:36 AM.

Following the meeting a work session was held with Sheriff Kevin Glendening regarding the Sheriff's K9 Unit and the Departments Fitness Incentive.
