- d. Budget Discussion- There was discussion on a few items on the budget-First, it salary was discussed. It was proposed by Vice Chair Sheriff Kevin Glendening to provide a 5% salary increase for the FY26 budget siting cost of living increase and aligining with comprable wages of EMA's with similar county sizes around the state. Second, Chair Broeker discuessed that the Sheriff's department has a 4-wheel drive vehicle that EMA could have in lieu of purchasing one- therefore, we could remove \$10,000.00 from the vehicle budget. Third, the \$1500.00 for office equipment and furniature could be removed due to another department providing new office equipment. Lastly, the actual cost of family health insurance for FY26 is \$21,552.00 which is a difference of -1,328.00.

The budget was accepted with the changes discussed. It was motioned by Mayor Ron Teater, seconded by Mayor Jon Billups. *Motion Passed*.
